## Accolades

- Represented Renren shareholders on derivative claims under Cayman law brought in New York state court arising from a scheme by company insiders to wrongfully take the company's billion-dollar investment portfolio for themselves. The \$300 million direct-pay settlement approved in June 2022 was one of the largest cash settlements of a derivative action in history.
- Represented the Chapter 7 Trustee of The Northwest Company, a leading branded textiles manufacturer, in claims against company insiders. Obtained pre-judgment attachment of foreign defendant's interest in real estate holding companies, leading to favorable settlement.
